Emergency financial assistance and housing:

Organization	Residential Assistance for Families in Transition (RAFT) DHCD Program, Administered at Community Teamwork Inc.
Programs and Description	 Provides short-term financial assistance to low-income families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless Eligible uses include moving cost assistant, rent and utility overdue payments, rental stipends, or utility bills For families who must move; security deposit, first/last month's rent, utility startup costs and furniture Maximum amount per family: \$4000/year
Cost	Eligibility: -Family must be homeless or at risk of homelessness -Low income -Must show that RAFT assistance will stabilize current housing situation (must have enough income to avoid homelessness AFTER to RAFT
Contact Information	To access, must complete a Housing Consumer Education Center (HCEC) Intake Assessment. Can walk in or call. In-person appointments are available for assistance in completing the application. Bring ID and proof of current income for all adult household members (including cash benefits) when applying.
