<p>MassHealth Prescription for Transportation PT-1 https://masshealth.ehs.state.ma.us/cwp/login.aspx</p>	<p>A non-emergency transportation to and from Mass Health covered services (doctor’s appointments, counseling, rehabilitation) when the patient is unable to access public or private transportation. Must be signed by a healthcare provider Plans with transportation coverage: Standard, CommonHealth, CarePlus *Make appt. with CSS to register for service Eligibility: patient does not have access to private transportation and has a medical condition that prevents him/her from using public transportation.</p>
