

Activity Pool Quick Start Guide

This Quick Start Guide provides a simple overview to your pool's setup process.

STEP ONE: Prepare the site.

Locate a clean and flat level area free of stones or sharp objects.

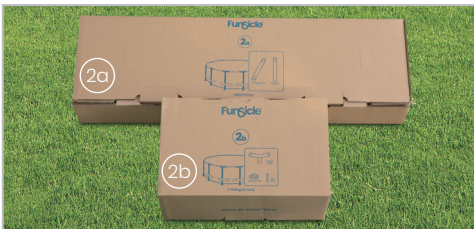
TIP: Let the liner sit under the sun for at least two hours before assembling the rest of the pool; this allows the liner material to be more flexible, making it easier for you to attach it to the beam frame structure.



STEP TWO: Assemble the pool frame and connect it to the liner.

1. Lay all parts (located in Boxes 2a & 2b) on the ground around the pool liner as shown below:

NOTE: For smaller pools, all metal frame and T-Fitting parts are packed in one box - number 2.



2. Slide the Horizontal Beams into the sleeves of the pool liner.

3. Connect each T-Fitting to the horizontal beams (each should snap into place).



4. Insert the Pins down through the top of the T-Fittings until the Pins snap into place on the lower side of the T-Fitting.



5. Carefully slide the Vertical Legs up through the liner's belt that runs around the middle of the pool, and then lock each one into the hold of the T-Fitting.



6. Continue working around the perimeter until the entire liner is securely connected to the frame.

7. To make sure the poles are perpendicular to the ground (and not leaning), pull out the vertical legs. This will make the walls straighter.



STEP THREE: Add 1 inch of water to the pool and then install filtration system.

1. After ensuring that the drain fitting is plugged securely and the cap is in place, fill the pool with about an inch of water. Then stop filling, and smooth out all wrinkles in the liner.



2. Install the filtration system as per the enclosed "Funsicle Skimmerplus Filter Pump User Guide."



3. Continue adding water to your pool and refer to the "Funsicle Activity Pool User Guide" for information and best practices for using, maintaining, draining, storing and/or winterizing your pool.
