

### First Aid Kit

First aid kits should be fully stocked at all times to ensure they are available to use as needed while out on shift. It is recommended that first aid kits in the van are inspected once a month and restocked as required to ensure they contain the correct quantities and that the contents are not out of date. Below is a list of the minimum contents found in a first aid kit used by Orange Sky. The replacement items can be purchased from chemists, pharmacies and supermarkets.

The contents of the first aid kit must be protected from dust and damage, easily accessible and kept in a container or bag that is easily recognisable (for example, a white cross on a green background prominently displayed on the outside).
