Suse acquires NeuVector to bolster Kubernetes security	NeuVector, a six-year-old San Jose-based startup with some \$19 million in venture capital funding, is pitched as a “full lifecycle” container security platform that scans for vulnerabilities through the entire development pipeline, from build to production, and includes automated tests for security and compliance.
New Android malware roots infected devices and takes complete control	Android malware is not new, but what makes AndroidEmu stand out is that malware with root capabilities is rare in 2021. According to the researchers, the ability to root has become harder as Android has matured, making it less useful for threat actors.
Instaclustr Elasticsearch cloud service becomes OpenSearch	The difference this time is more than a name change: OpenSearch has scrubbed artifacts such as trademark references. It's a more complete clean room engineered distribution based on the last official open-source versions of Elasticsearch and Kibana (version 7.10.2).
