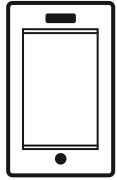

The Importance of Agile Identity Management

Why Does Identity Management Matter?

- Increasing security risks: Cyber threats and data breaches
- Growing complexity: Multiple apps, cloud environments, hybrid systems
- Compliance pressures: GDPR, HIPAA, SOC 2
- Evolving Business needs: Faster onboarding, better user experience, and operational efficiency

The Role of Agile Methodology:

- Flexibility and adaptability in a fast-evolving digital landscape.
- Continuous improvement through iteration.
- Responding quickly to business and regulatory changes.

Key Components of an Agile Identity Management Framework

- **Identity Lifecycle Management**
 - Automation user onboarding, access change, and offboarding.
 - Minimizing manual errors and delays.
- **Access Management**
 - Role-based and attribute-based access control.
 - Automating policy enforcement across systems.
- **Self-Service & Workflow Automation**
 - User-driven requests (e.g., password reset, access requests).
 - Automated approval workflows for faster access provisioning.
- **Audit & Compliance Automation**
 - Automated reports, access reviews, and recertifications.

Key Considerations when Implementing an Agile Identity Management Framework

- **Compliance Requirements**
 - Ensure alignment
- **User Experience**
 - User-Friendly to minimize disruption
- **Scalability**
 - Accommodate Future Growth and Business Needs
- **Training and Awareness**
 - Educate users

- **Strong Authentication**
- **Role-Based Access Control**
- **Centralized Identity Management**
- **Zero Trust Security**
- **Least Privilege Principle**
- **Automated Provisioning and De-Provisioning**
- **Auditing and Monitoring**

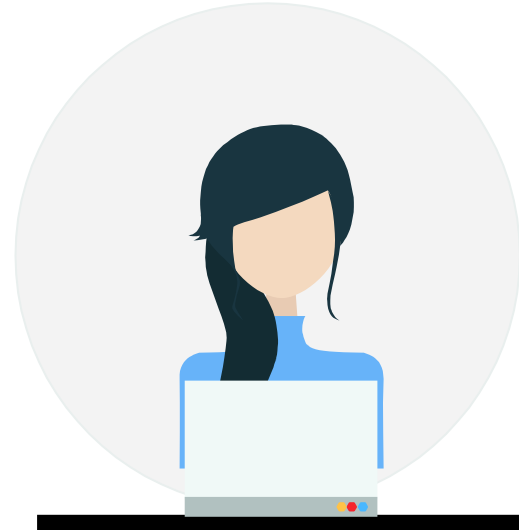
