

HALLOWEEN

- Use decorative fonts as graphic elements to enhance page content.
- Avoid long copy blocks of bold or all caps, and avoid all caps when using a script font.

BODY

- All type is meant to be read. Make sure your story is set in a clearly readable font.
- Never change font size or leading within a section.
- Serif fonts in 10–12 pt are best for body copy.
- Choose a font that includes a bold and italic version for your body copy.
- Black type on a white background is easiest to read.

CAPTIONS

 Choose a sans serif font set in 8 – 9 pt for easy to read captions.

- Choose 3 main fonts for consistency. One each for headlines, body copy, and captions. Use decorative fonts as graphic elements only.
- Headlines should be set in at least 30 pts, in serif or sans serif fonts. Use "decorative" fonts sparingly.
