

## HT Vista - Pre-installation e-mail

- Provide WIFI speed and network details:
  - HT Vista requires an internet upload speed of 5mbps or faster. Please check
    the WIFI speed by going to speedtest.net and clicking on GO while connected
    to the WIFI.
  - Please let us know the WIFI name and password in advance to keep the installation process to avoid interruption to the practice.
- Prepare 3-4 patients (dogs only) to visit the clinic half an hour after the time of the training. Several guidelines can help you choose the right patient:



- HT Vista is designed to scan dermal and subcutaneous lumps not deeper than 0.5cm under the skin.
- Every palpable mass can be scanned **except the following**:
  - Lymph nodes, mammary glands, and testicular tumors
  - Masses located on the phalanx, footpads, or face tumors

Choose the HT Vista location in the clinic before our arrival:

We recommend locating it in the examination room, where you receive a good WIFI signal and close to an electrical socket. Please let me know if you have any questions.
