


# PRODUCT UPDATE

## New and Improved Specs & Certs

On Sunday, September 8th 2024, Steelhead will be releasing an update to Specs and Certs. This update improves flexibility, efficiency, and specificity for adding Spec Measurements to Parts and creating Certificates.

#### Improvements to processing Parts with Specs:

• Spec Measurements will now be associated to a Part Transfer Account, rather than a Work Order/Part Number combination. This gives you the

ability to **get more specific**, and the option to edit Specs.


- \*\*A **Part Transfer Account** (PTA or Part Account) is essentially an account (id) that represents the unique state of a Parts' movement. Parts can be added to an existing Account if its state is identical to that of the already existing PTA.\*\*
  - There's a new button to easily Split and Reallocate measurements on Parts.
     (See step-by-step overview here)
  - Resolving Failed Spec Measurements is updated to apply to ALL Part
     Accounts associated to that measurement. (See step-by-step overview here)
  - The "COLLECT ADDITIONAL" button in the Specs Results page has an updated dialog box. When recording Spec Measurements, you assign them to individual Part Accounts, allowing you to get more specific. (See step-bystep overview here)



### Improvements to Cert creation workflows:


- You can create and finalize a Certification in just a few clicks.
- You have the option to include or exclude certain measurements.
- You can certify Partial Shipments.
- Master Certs are being replaced with a more efficient way to certify multiple Part Accounts at once.

New look for creating Certs to reduce clicking and improve efficiency.

\* Note that the number bubble on Packing Slips in the Shipping dashboard will now be based on Part Accounts with Certs to total Part Accounts on that Packing Slip. This quickly tells you how many Part Accounts have or have not been Certified for that Packing Slip.



We hope that these updates will help you save time and have your shop running more efficiently. Again, this update is currently planned for release on September 8th, 2024.
