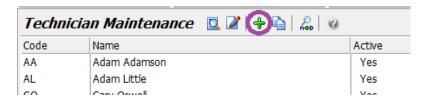
HOW TO CONFIGURE AND PROCESS JOB TIMES

Introduction

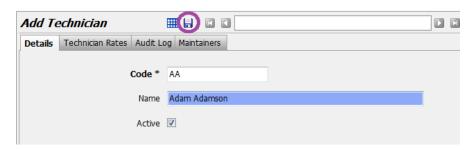
This guide demonstrates how to add technicians, job types and labour categories to your system so that you can include job times on your work orders and invoices and use job time reports to display useful information such as technician efficiency and utilisation and the accuracy of your job time estimates.

Add Technicians

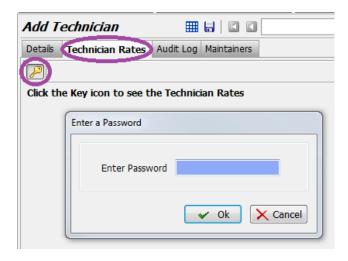
From the Marlin GTX menu, select System > System Files > People > Technician.



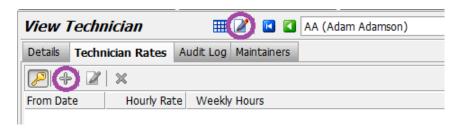
• To add a new technician, click on the Add icon.



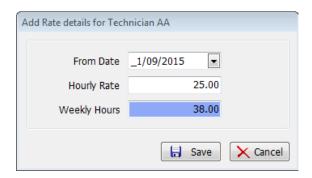
• Enter the information, tick the Active checkbox to make the technician available and click on the Save icon.



• Select the Technician Rates tab, click on the key icon and enter the password to view the rates.



• To add a new rate, click on the Edit mode icon at the top and then on the Add icon.

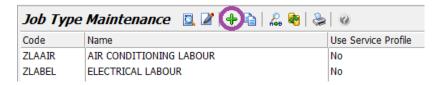


• Enter the appropriate information and click on the Save icon. (Note: if this employee's rate will change in future, add another rate with the new start date and new rate).

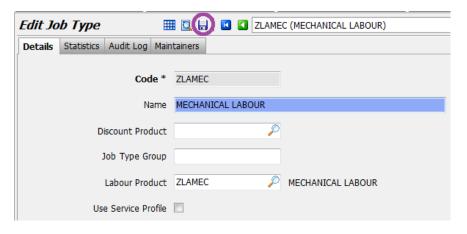
Add Job Types

Note: Before creating Job Types, confirm that you have a unique, unstocked Labour Product Code setup for each Job Type that you will create.

• From the Marlin GTX menu, select System > System Files > Vehicle Service Jobs > Job Types.



To add a new Job Type, click on the Add icon.



• Enter the appropriate information and then click on the Save icon. The Labour Product is the labour product code that you setup for this job type.

Add Labour Categories

From the Marlin GTX menu, select System > System Files > Vehicle Service Jobs > Labour Category.



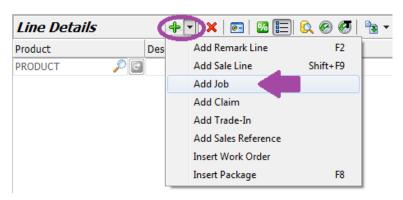
• To add a new Labour Category, click on the Add icon.



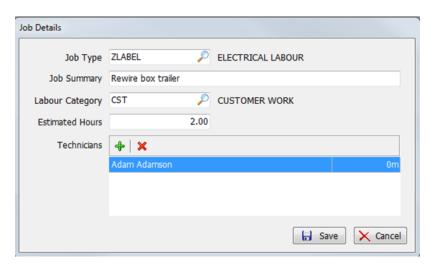
• Enter the appropriate information and click on the Save icon.

Include Job Times on Work Orders and Invoices

- Complete the details in the top section of a Work Order or Invoice as normal.
- Click on the Add New Line icon and select Add Job.

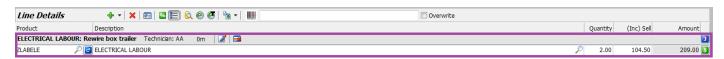


Key in, or use the drop down lists, to enter the relevant details of the job and add a technician.



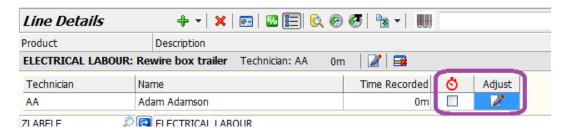
Upon saving, a grey job header line will appear on the invoice or work order, including the Job Type description, Job Summary and Technician(s) you selected. It will also show that '0m' (0 minutes) have been applied to the job.

Below the job header line will be a line item for the Job Type you selected, including quantity and pricing details.



- Add additional product lines as appropriate for this job.
- Repeat the process above to include multiple jobs on a work order or invoice.

Clicking on the Show Details 🔟 icon (at right end of job header line) displays the technician(s) working on the job.



- Tick the red clock checkbox if you wish to start the auto timer for a technician. The elapsed minutes will be displayed in the Time Recorded column. Untick the checkbox when you wish to stop the clock for that technician.
- Alternatively, click on the icon in the Adjust column to manually enter or change the total time the technician has spent on the job.

You can also adjust job times in the Planner on the 'Jobs' tab. Click on the Adjust icon on a job to access the auto clock or enter hours manually, without opening the work order or invoice.



Job Times Reports

• From the Marlin GTX menu, select **Reports > Job Times Reports** and you will see that there are three reports available. Note that these reports should be generated for a period of at least one week to be meaningful.
