<div>2</div> <p><b>Registration of Agent/Importer/Agent Importer through FoSIM</b></p>	<p>All Agent / Importer / Agent Importer must register with Food Safety Information System of Malaysia (FoSIM).</p> <p>FoSIM interfaces with the Customs Information System (CIS), allowing importers, forwarding agents and Authorized Offices to manage food importation activities electronically.</p> <p>Please click <a href="#">here</a> for guideline on using FoSIM.</p>
<div>3</div> <p><b>Notification of food importation through FoSIM</b></p>	<p>All Agent / Importer / Agent Importer are required to fill in details (purpose/good details) via FoSIM. The food's details are filled in through 'SMK Interface' menu in FoSIM.</p>
<div>4</div> <p><b>Inspection of Food at Entry Points</b></p>	<p>Inspection is carried out by Ministry of Health (MOH) officers via risk-based approach assisted by FoSIM.</p> <p>Food imported may require import permit/license/fulfilment of other requirements from other government agencies (OGA) such as Malaysian Quarantine and Inspection Services (MAQIS), Department of Veterinary Services Malaysia (DVS), Department of Agriculture (DOA) etc.</p>
<div>5</div> <p><b>Final approval by Royal Malaysian Customs Department</b></p>	<p>Payment of import tax/duties (if any) and fulfillment of requirements of Royal Malaysian Customs Department.</p>
