Amend Award

New feature that allows customers to make amendments to fee, delivery date and scope comments after an RFP has been awarded.

Amendment document and notice templates are also configurable from the System settings area.

Reg B compliance

"Send Doc" category is added to Task code management section and is used to enable Reg B compliance workflow.

File Attachments

Added capability to send files from RIMS to external recipients.

Users will be able select one or more files from job attachment and customize the recipient/s and email message. These transactions are recorded in the Notification and Job Change Log.

Ability for Vendors to save individual bids within a portfolio before submitting it to the lender.

Ability to save users with non-US nation.

Changes to vendor's insurance information from User management are logged and can be viewed from User Change Log page.

Service Request

Printable View

Fixed Service Request Printable view issue that caused some users to see larger fonts when printing.

USABILITY IMPROVEMENTS

Project/Job/Property Change Log

Change Log view is redesigned. The search panel has been removed to increase the space available for change log information. Searching capability has been integrated into the change log table.

User Change Log result set has been increased to return up to 5,000 records.
