We've corrected an issue in the 46.00 engine where subject and comp values were applying as scientific formats in the comp tables and were thus unable to calculate Distances.

We've corrected an issue where Tax Comps were not keeping their arranged order when user added or removed comps after the first application.

We've corrected an issue where some "Parking" attributes were not importing from the subject in web.

We've corrected an issue in the Expense Grid where the subject data for Taxes always pulled from the Assessment worksheet. Now the default pulls from the field: Tax Expense which is instanced.
