

# **New Features and Enhancements**

# Job Manager

# **Job Manager User Interface**


The Job Manager interface has been redesigned with an improved Job Detail window and more powerful search tools. The new Job Details window has an improved vertical layout with numerous new fields and features. Each section can be collapsed making it easy to find and edit relevant data.






# **Job Manager Advanced Search**

It is now possible to search for multiple instances of each filter in the Job Manager. For example, it is possible to search for numerous different Parcel IDs and Addresses, and results matching any of those criteria will be returned.



# **Job Manager Search Map**

After conducting a search in the N1-Web Job Manager, a button titled *Show Map* will appear in the search options bar at the top of the screen. Click this button to display a map. Each of the Properties that appear in the search results, including those that appear on subsequent pages of the search results, are marked with pins on the map. Hover the mouse over a pin to see more information about that Property.



#### **Zip Code Field in Job Manager**

Previously, the Zip Code field did not appear with the other address information when creating or editing a Job on the Job Details screen in N1-Web. It has been added and can be manually entered along with the other address fields.

#### **Job Manager Retainer Field**

A new field has been added to the Job Details screen of the N1-Web Job Manager: Retainer Fee. This field appears in both Excel and PDF exports.



# **Job Manager County Field**

A County field has been added to the N1-Web Job Manager. It appears in the Subject Property section of the Job Details screen. The County field is available in both the Basic and Advanced Job Search, and multiple Counties can be included in the Advanced Search. The County field is included in the CSV export, but not the PDF export.



#### **Time of Sale Section and Fields**

A new *Time of Sale* section has been added to the General page in N1-Web. Eight fields have been added to this section:

- Cap Rate
- Occupancy Rate
- Vacancy Rate
- Number of Tenants
- Weighted Avg. Lease Term
- Price Per Rentable Space
- Price Per Useable Arce Land
- Price Per Useable SF Land


This allows the user to enter those values at the time of sale and then save the values by clicking the *Add+* button. The record of that sale and all other recorded sales for the Property can be viewed by clicking on the *View Sale History button*.



## **Data Source Field**

A Data Source field has been added to the Transaction Data section found on the General Page. This new field can be used as the data source for Sales – an additional Data Source field has been added to the Comm Lease Rent Detail grid and can be found using the Column Chooser tool.






# **Appraisal Usage Field**

A new drop-down menu has been added to the General page in N1-Web: Appraisal Usage. This menu allows the user to apply one of the following labels to the Property record:

- Subject: The Property is only intended to be used as a Subject
- Comparable: The Property is only intended to be used as a Comparable
- Both: The Property can be used as either a Subject or Comparable

When a Property is created through Platform Integration, the default Appraisal Usage is *Subject*. When a subject Property is created through Excel, the Appraisal Usage is *Subject*. A new field titled *Appraisal Usage* has been added to the Property Search page, allowing the user to search Property records by one of the three Appraisal Usage values: *Subject, Comparable, Both.* Users will see a new banner at the top for parcels that are not ready to be used as comparables.





# **Fields on Improvements and Multifamily Lease Pages**


Four new fields have been added to the Improvements page in N1-Web and one new field has been added to the Multifamily Lease page:

- Percent Retail
- Parking Ratio GBA
- Parking Ratio GLA
- Parking Ratio Unit
- Average MF Unit Size

# **Property Search Fields**


Eight new fields have been added to Property Search in N1-Web - These fields correspond to the new Time of Sale fields added to the Transaction Data section of the General page in N1-Web.






#### **View Jobs Button**

A *View Jobs* button has been added to the Property search. Select one or more Properties from the search results and then click the View Jobs button to see the Jobs associated with those Properties.



## **Thumbnails in Property Search**

The Thumbnails column has been removed from the default Property Search layout in N1-Web to improve page load time. The column can be re-added to the layout by using the Column Chooser tool found at the bottom of the search results.



# Contacts Manager

#### **Contacts Manager**

Several new fields have been added to the Contacts Manager tool in N1-Web:

- Phone 2: available for Companies, Contacts, and Appraisers
- Salutation: available for Contacts and Appraisers
- Designation: available for Contacts and Appraisers
- County: available for Contacts
- Address 2: available for Contacts

#### **Phone Number Field**

Previously, the Phone field in N1-Web Contacts Manager only accepted extensions of up to three digits. All Contacts Manager Phone fields, including those found in Contacts, Companies, and Appraisers, now accept four-digit extensions.

Upon logging into N1-Web, users will now be brought to the All/Sales Properties search page.

# **Bug Fixes and Usability Improvements**

N1-Excel

### Fixed: Price per RA

The Price per RA field did not properly import from N1-Web to Excel. This issue has been fixed.

# **Printed Comp Sheets**

# Fixed: FAR and Land to Building Ratio Decimals

When printing comparable sheets directly from N1-Web, the Land to Building Ratio and FAR fields displayed an excessive number of digits after the decimal point. This has been fixed; these fields will display up to four digits after the decimal point.

# **Fixed: Cap Rate Prints**

The Cap Rate was multiplied by 100x when printing N1-Web comparable sheets. This has been fixed; the Cap Rate now prints the correct, non-multiplied value.

# **Fixed: Vacancy Rate on Printed Comparable Sheet**

When printing a Multifamily Lease Comparable from N1-Web, the Vacancy Rate appeared as a dollar value, rather than a percentage, for some users. This has been fixed; the Vacancy Rate now appears correctly as a percentage.

# **Property** Search

#### **Fixed: Year Built Search**

When conducting a Property search in N1-Web, it was not possible to search between two dates for the Year Built field. A new field has been added to allow searching between two dates: Year Built Numeric. It is possible to search this field using the following operators: equal to; greater than; less than; between. To search for records by Year Built with the above operators, enter the Year Built values in the new Year Built Numeric field.





# Record Mgmt. Fixed: Usable Acres to Usable Land SF Conversion

Previously, when converting the value entered in the Usable Acres field to Usable Land SF, N1-Web did not include any digits past the decimal point. This diverged from the calculation done from the Acres field to the Land SF field, which included one digit after the decimal point. This has been fixed; the Usable Land SF field now displays up to one digit past the decimal point when converting from Usable Acres.

## **Fixed: Property Names**

Previously, users were prohibited from including apostrophes in Property names. It is now possible to include apostrophes, as well as the following special characters in Property Names: .,-& (period, comma, dash, ampersand).

# **Job Manager**

# Fixed: Exporting a List Filtered by Zip Code

When conducting a search by Zip Code in the N1-Web Jobs Manager, only results that matched the search criteria were returned. When that list was exported to Excel, however, the Zip Code search criteria was ignored, and all Jobs were exported. This has been fixed; when exporting, only search results that match the search criteria are included.

# Fixed: Exporting Zip Code Data in Jobs Manager

When exporting to Excel from the N1-Web Jobs Manager, Zip Code data was not included in the export. This has been fixed; Zip Code data is now included when exporting to Excel. It is not included when exporting to PDF.

#### Fixed: Fee Field in Job Search

When searching Jobs in N1-Web by Fee, the user was only given a single input field, making it impossible to search for a range. This has been fixed; the Fee search now includes two input fields, allowing the user to search a range.
