Overview

Sampling is a multi-level decision model to support a risk-based process. Sampling can also be considered a workflow escalation tool within RIMS.

Why call this feature Sampling?

Original use was for escalation from compliance reviews to technical reviews for regulatory compliance programs only.

When did Sampling become available?

Sampling has been a part of RIMS with a limited feature set for years The expanded (current) Sampling feature was released in January 2017 as part of 8.8.0

Use Cases (examples): You want to...

- automatically create a review task when an order task is closed
- create a technical review task when a compliance review is completed under select conditions (original use)
- create a Phase I order task when a transaction screen review reveals a significant environmental condition
- create a Phase II order when a Phase I review calls for further investigation
- create a new Draw Inspection task when current Draw Inspection review is completed / closed



Selection – how/when is sampling invoked?

- When a user <u>closes a task</u> that matches a corresponding Sampling record's selection criteria:
 - Nation, State, Job Type, Task Code, Disposition

Logic (process)


- Sampling is a five-step process that would generate a Sampling ACTION only if one of those five steps results in selection:
 - Loan Amount greater than threshold
 - Frequency denominator for simple selection; 1/n
 - Vendor Score vendor average rating less than threshold
 - No Review no scorecard within #Months if more than #Awards
 - Review Frequency less than #Scorecards within #MonthsScore




- Maintenance


- Maintenance (continued)
 - Edit any existing Sampling record by clicking the pencil icon on the appropriate row
 - Add new record by clicking the '+ Expand Entry Form' link





Change Log

 Changes made in the Sampling maintenance pages are logged including date, user and changes made for ease of monitoring and coordinating changes.





Action Dialog

When sampling is invoked, a dialog is presented prompting the user to select a Job Manager and Due Date for the new Task to be created


Default JM is the current Task's JM but any JM may be selected or searched

Default Due Date is the Due Date of the current Task

- Notifications
 - Notifications are generated for any action chosen (create task or Cancel) based on the content and recipients in the Notice Management area (Sampling Event) – see Further Action / No Further Action Req.



- Job Change Log
 - Actions taken or cancellations by the JM will be logged in the Job Change Log



Known Limitations & Future Enhancements

- Currently limited to a single state for each Sampling record
- Due Date default in the user prompt dialog is Today
- Extend functionality to allow the addition of a Service (new Job) as opposed to just adding a new Task.
- Add a more dynamic Reason element for each record (optional) to allow a more descriptive dialog box.
