ENHANCEMENTS

Template Scope of Work, Dates, Premises

We've added several name ranges to facilitate the import of job data: _N1IntendedUseType, _N1IntendedUserType, _N1ReportType, _N1InspectionDate, _N1ValueType, _N1InterestAppraisedType

Engine Subject Import

Added support for importing Inspection Date from the job record.
